* Participants in Semi-Private lessons must pre-arrange their own groups before registering; groups are not arranged by HOP staff. It is recommended that participants are not more than 1 level apart.

Lesson Policies:

- Once registered and paid there will be no refunds. If withdrawal becomes necessary **before** session start, a credit will be issued for future registrations in the 2017 season. Credits will not be carried over year to year. Credits or transfers will not be given after session start. Transfers before session start are by availability only. Requests must be made in writing at pool office.
- Participants are to attend all classes as scheduled for the program session in which they are registered. In the event that a participant is unable to attend a scheduled class(es) during the session, make-up classes or credits for missed class(es) will not be provided. We reserve the right to adjust class times and or combine classes as needed due to low enrolment.
- A pro-rated refund may be given due to unsafe weather or mechanical problems causing the loss of more than 3 in water classes. Lessons will run rain or shine and during cooler temperatures. In the event of very inclement weather, dry activities and water safety will be taught. Highwood Outdoor Pool is heated.
- The wading pool is **closed** to parents & children staying on deck at the pool as spectators during lessons. The Pool staff and Lifeguards have complete authority. The onsite supervisor has the right to allow or prevent access to any part of the pool(s) or facility should there be any concerns regarding the patron's use of the facility.
- Please ensure that swimmers arrive at least 5 minutes early for lesson start, and that they have visited the washroom before the lesson begins. Please take your child un-showered to the designated meeting points. The instructors will collect classes for attendance from this location.
- Parents and children are asked to sit and observe at least 4 meters away from the pool basin so adequate space is available for teaching groups, lifeguards & instructors to move safely.
- For your child's safety, all children under the age of 7 must be within arms reach of a responsible person age 14+ **at all times** when on deck or in the pool facility.
- Please do not interrupt or call out to the instructor or your child during an active lesson as this is distracting for the instructor, your child and other swimmers.
- Verbal or physical abuse of staff will not be tolerated. People who violate this policy will be asked to leave the facility. Refunds will not be provided.
- To help us maintain great quality pool water, please leave your outdoor shoes on the racks provided. Pick up and place your garbage or recyclables in one of the bins provided. Please change diapers in the change rooms and not on the pool deck, picnic tables or grassy areas.
- We cannot guarantee the assignment of a swimmer to any particular instructor. You may indicate a preference; understanding that it may not be possible to accommodate your request.
