Lesson Policies:

- Once you have registered & paid there will be no refunds issued. If withdrawal becomes necessary, a credit for the amount paid will be held at the pool for the current 2013 season so the participant may take their lessons in another session or as a private lesson availability permitting.
- A pro-rated refund may be given due to unsafe weather or mechanical problems causing the loss of more than 2 in water classes.
- We reserve the right to change class times and or combine classes due to low participant numbers. Due to instructor / participant ratios, missed classes cannot be made up. Lessons will run during inclement weather, cool temperatures & rain, but not during unsafe weather (thunder & lightning)
- The wading pool is closed to parents & children staying on deck at the pool as spectators during lessons. The Pool staff and Lifeguards have complete authority. The onsite supervisor has the right to allow or prevent access to any part of the pool(s) or facility should there be any concerns regarding the patron's use of the facility.
- Please ensure that your children arrive at least 5 minutes early for lesson start, and that they have visited the washroom before the lesson begins.
- Parents and other children are asked to sit at least 12 feet away from the pool edge/deck so adequate space is available for teaching groups & instructors.
- All children under the age of 7 must be within arms reach of a responsible person age 14+ at all times when on deck or in the pool facility.
- Please do not interrupt or call out to the instructor or your child during an active lesson as this is distracting for the instructor, your child and other swimmers.
- Verbal or physical abuse of staff will not be tolerated. Violators will be asked to leave the facility. No refunds for lessons will be provided.
